Application and Conditions:

Cost: \$25 per site including GST. No extra monies will be taken in the form of commission. Fees must be paid at least one week prior to the event. Payment and acceptance of fees by Territory Craft is necessary to secure a site. Payment and booking can be made over the phone, or by sending back the form at the bottom of this page. However, please contact the at Territory Craft office BEFORE returning the form to confirm site booking.

Site: Approximately 9 sq / m will be allocated to each site holder. Extra space may be negotiated prior to the fair. An extra fee may apply for extra space. Each site holder will be provided with a trestle table and 2 chairs, additional requirements will attract additional costs. Refreshments will be available for purchase.

Items For Sale: All items offered for sale must be created by the site holder or the group they represent

Hours of Access: Site holders may have vehicular access to sites (where appropriate and not on grass) from 9 am to 9.50 am and from 4.10 pm to 5 pm on Saturday 12 August 2006. The Showcase runs from 10 am to 4 pm. All sites should be packed up and clear of goods and litter by 5pm.

Parking: Parking is available in the Museum & Art Gallery car park, and in Conacher St. Parking is not available on the Territory Craft access road. All vehicles must be removed from the grounds and access roads during the conduct of the fair.

Insurance: Territory Craft's public liability insurance will cover stall holders for the duration of this major event.

Advertising: Territory Craft will endeavour to promote the event as widely as possible via newspaper, radio, community announcements, tourist agencies, fliers and the Darwin Festival marketing program

Territory Craft reserves the right to accept or reject any site application at its discretion. The Territory Craft Board reserves the right to cancel a site holder's application if the site holder breaches the conditions of this agreement or displays unacceptable behaviour whilst on Territory Craft premises. The Territory Craft Staff and Board members are in charge of the proceedings on the day.
